**ABOUT THE LITURGY:**

**One Last Week of Easter:**

We've had seven Sundays of Easter so far. How are you doing with keeping the energy and joy of Easter Sunday all season long? With the end of the season in sight, and everyone beginning to focus on graduations, vacations, and summer activities, it can be difficult to keep your focus on the Easter mysteries. But you still have one more week to reinvigorate your Easter spirit! Here are a few simple ways to do that:

*Take an Easter walk:* Take a walk around your neighborhood, in your yard or garden, at the park, or even at the local shopping center. Look for signs of new life all around you. Remember the neophytes - those who were baptized this Easter - who are "new plants" in the household of God.

*Remember your baptism:* Search for photos and other mementos of your own baptism, for example, your baptismal gown or certificate. Place them in a prominent spot in your home this week.

*Make bathing a time of renewal:* Whenever you shower or bathe, recall how the neophytes were bathed in the font. Make it a special time of prayer by giving thanks to Christ, the Water of Life.

*Write a thank you note:* "Eucharist" means "thanksgiving" in Greek. Each day this last week of Easter, write a thank you note or email to someone you appreciate but don't often thank in a special way. Say a prayer for him or her as you seal the envelope or hit "send."

For the past year, we have had the pleasure of the presence of **Father Justin Cinnante, O.Carm.**, in our midst. He has been serving as the Campus Minister at John S. Burke Catholic High School while living at Mount Carmel Priory and occasionally offering Sunday Mass here.
